### Areas to be cleared:

### AREA 1 - Main Hall

- Main Hall
- Toilet

### FIRE MARSHAL 1\*.

### AREA 2 - Entrance Hall Disabled Toilet & Kitchen

- Entrance Hall
- 1 Toilet
- Kitchen

FIRE MARSHAL 2\*

\*Responsibility to nominate a Designated Fire Marshalls will be with the hirer.

They should be made aware of the following instructions

### **Duties on Discovering a Fire**

- 1. Sound the alarm by shouting 'Fire'.
- 2. On hearing the alarm, telephone the Fire Service (dial 999/112) using a mobile phone.
- 3. On hearing the alarm, evacuate the building checking areas as above, closing all doors as they leave and proceed to the assembly point.
- 4. This building is single storey and anyone with mobility difficulties may be evacuated.
- 5. Fire exits are located –

### **Entrance Hall**

Main Entrance doors

### Main Hall

Far wall (opposite main doors)

### Kitchen

• If either the above exits are blocked use the exterior door in the room. The key should be in the lock on arrival, if not contact a member of the committee.

### THE ASSEMBLY POINT IS AT THE FRONT OF THE HALL BY THE GATE

Nominated people or fire marshalls must supervise safe evacuation, ensuring areas as listed above are clear.

- 6. If possible, designate someone to remain at the front door to prevent the public from entering.
- 7. Fire Marshalls should check their areas are clear and proceed to the assembly point and confirm they are clear to the Hirer and the fire service.

### When Dealing with a Fire

- 1. If electrical appliances are involved, <u>and you can safely do so</u>, switch off the current before evacuating.
- 2. Shut doors and windows (if possible) on the way out.

### DO NOT ATTEMPT TO TACKLE THE FIRE YOURSELF

### **DO NOT TAKE ANY PERSONAL RISKS**

Please be aware - the use of fire extinguishers to put out any but the smallest fire is not

advised, and, therefore, no specific training in the use of fire extinguishers is provided.

### FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE LOCATED -

### **Entrance Hall:**

• Right hand side of the kitchen door: 1 x Powder

### Main Hall:

• Right hand side of the Fire Exit door: 1 x Water

### Kitchen:

Fire Blanket between the entrance hall and main hall door

### On Hearing the shout of Fire

Evacuate all members of the public, contractors etc., from your designated area and proceed to the assembly point.

### DO NOT ALLOW ANYONE TO STOP AND COLLECT PERSONAL POSSESSIONS

### **Reminder to All**

- To study these instructions and know what to do in the event of a fire.
- To make yourself familiar with all means of escape.
- To ensure all means of escape are not obstructed by boxes, equipment etc., at any time.
